

FOCUS ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF YOUR CHILD

We believe that good collaboration between childcare and elementary education is the future. That's why we focus on an ongoing learning line for children from 0 to 13 years old. Our goal? To guide, stimulate and inspire children while growing up. This is how we lay a good foundation and enhance their chances and happiness in life.

CHILDCARE AND EDUCATION GO HAND IN HAND

The connection between childcare and school is also practical: at most locations, we offer childcare and elementary school under one roof. We take care of your child at one familiar location, where childcare workers and teachers work together.

WHAT IS CHILDCARE?

We offer childcare for children from 0 to 4 years old. Between 7.30 AM and 6.30 PM we take care of your child in a safe space, where the childcare workers know your child and offer activities that suit your child's development. Is your child (almost) between 2 and 4 years old? We also offer special toddler care, to prepare our children for elementary school.

THE GROUP

At our bigger locations, we offer childcare in two different age groups: children from 0 to 2 years old and children from 2 to 4 years old. At our smaller locations we offer childcare in groups with children from 0 to 4 years old, at some locations combined with pre-school.

AT LEAST TWO HALF-DAYS A WEEK

For pedagogical reasons, we request that your child goes to childcare at least two half-days a week. The morning is from 7.30 AM to 1.00 PM, the afternoon is from 1.00 PM to 6.30 PM. Some of our locations only offer full days of childcare. Other locations also offer half-days of childcare. Check your options at your location or at our child planning department.

THE SUBSCRIPTIONS OF CHILDCARE WE OFFER

CHILDCARE: 52-WEEKS SUBSCRIPTION

- Guaranteed childcare on fixed days (school weeks and holidays)
- Exchange service (read more on page 6)
- Financial compensation for public holidays
- 52 weeks of childcare; you pay for 51 weeks of childcare

CHILDCARE: 48-WEEKS SUBSCRIPTION

- Childcare for 48 weeks a year on fixed days or fixed half-days
- When you plan your holidays is up to you. You can easily cancel these days in the parent portal.

CHILDCARE: SCHOOL WEEKS SUBSCRIPTION

- Childcare only in school weeks (not during holidays)
- EXTRA CHILDCARE BETWEEN 7.00 7.30 AM
 - Early childcare
 - We offer breakfast between 7.00 7.30 AM
 - Only at several of our locations; check your options at the location of your choice

• EXTRA CHILDCARE

- For extra childcare in addition to your regular days
- Request through the parent portal
- Request will be reviewed by the group. You can expect a yes or a no at least eight weeks in advance.
- The extra day of childcare will be billed in the month where the extra day takes place

CHILDCARE DURING HOLIDAYS

During holidays and study days, the childcare of some locations will take place at another GOO-location nearby. The biggest advantage of our childcare locations working together during holidays, is that there will be more peers for your child to play with and that we can offer challenging activities for every age group. Check the website of your location to see if this applies to your childcare location.

CHILDCARE ALLOWANCE

The mentioned prices in the table above are not the net prices the childcare cost you as a parent, if you are entitled to receive childcare allowance from the government: *kinderopvangtoeslag*. You can easily calculate the amount of your allowance and the net hourly rate, using the calculation tool on our website. The *Belastingdienst* calculates your allowance based on your taxable income. The hourly rates that we use are gross amounts and will be converted into a fixed monthly rate.

HOW TO APPLY FOR CHILDCARE ALLOWANCE?

You need to apply for the allowance on the website of the *Belastingdienst* via *Mijn toeslagen* or by using the app *Kinderopvangtoeslag.* Don't forget to pass on price changes or a changed amount of hours of childcare. If you do so timely, you will receive the correct allowance. After starting the childcare, you need to let the *Belastingdienst* know within three months. In case of changes, you need to inform the *Belastingdienst* within four weeks.

COMMUNICATION THROUGH THE PARENT PORTAL

As a parent, it is important to know how your child is doing, also when you are not around. We think communication with parents is very important. We communicate with parents through the parent portal. Here, you find photos of your child doing activities in the group, newsletters and messages, as well as bills, annual statements and other important documents like the terms, conditions and protocols.

Do you know in advance that your child will not be attending childcare at your regular day? Please let us know through the parent portal. It helps us with our staff planning. And it gives other parents the possibility to exchange a day. If you cancel a day of childcare through the parent portal, it will be turned into absence credit. You can check your absence credit in the parent portal.

If you let us know your child won't be attending childcare at least 48 hours in advance	30 days before the date or 60 days after
In case your regular day of childcare falls on a national holiday	30 days before the date or 60 days after

EXCHANGE SERVICE

Our exchange service gives you the opportunity to swap a day (or half a day) of childcare. You can request the exchange days through the parent portal and use the absence credit without extra charge. You can find the terms and conditions of our exchange service on our website and in the parent portal.

NOTICE PERIOD

Do you want to end your contract or reduce the amount of days or half-days? The notice period is one month.

NATIONAL HOLIDAYS

- We are closed on national holidays; check the list below
- Our facilities close at 5 PM on December 5th, December 24th and December 31st
- On wednesday April 10th 2024, we have planned a GOO inspiration day for our staff. Our facilities are closed on this day. Is this your fixed day of childcare? Then you will receive financial compensation.
